The giant baobab trees are a majestic icon of Africa, a tree of life, a symbol of power and resilience connecting nature, culture, and humanity. They provide shelter and a communal gathering place as well as food and medicine from their fruits and leaves.

Dr. Anat Robinson's photograph of a group of baobab trees taken at sunset in Madagascar echoes these sentiments. Silhouetted against the background of the fiery African sky, the group stands tall, strong, and unwavering. They stand together giving support to each other and to the birds nesting in their branches.

Dr. Robinson was born in Tel Aviv, Israel. She is an ophthalmologist and was the head of the ophthalmic ambulatory services at Rabin Medical Center for 15 years. Dr. Robinson enjoys artistic photography, concentrating on interesting nature and people. Using the medium of photography, she captures the intersection of the individual and the surrounding forces of nature.

Dr. Robinson's photographs have been exhibited in Israel and abroad. She is a member of a forum of creative scientists in Israel who display their artistic works.

Dr. Robinson has taken many of her photographs from the sky, while flying in a powered parachute. This unique shooting angle allows her to achieve an awe-inspiring perception of nature's beauty. She also edits short videos.
