**Press Release:**

The Israeli Medical Association's (IMA) Ethics Board held its meeting on Tuesday, August 5, 2025, in Be'er Sheva, in solidarity with Soroka Medical Center, which was the target of a direct missile strike launched from Iran.

During the meeting, members of the board discussed issues related to medical ethics during armed conflict.

At the conclusion of the discussion, the Ethics Board reaffirmed the position paper titled "Assuring Medical and Health Services During the Israeli-Palestinian Armed Conflict", issued by the Israeli Medical Association. This paper reflects the IMA's policy over the past 20 years and is still considered relevant today.

The Ethics Board places great importance on continuing to address issues concerning medical ethics in times of armed conflict and intends to issue a dedicated position paper on the subject in the future.
