

General Guidelines

- Articles must be in English. Spelling, grammar, and clarity must be at an acceptable standard
 - Written approval from research supervisors is required for original research articles
 - Written consent from patients is required for case reports.
- The submission file is in OpenOffice, Microsoft Word, RTF, or WordPerfect document file format.
- The text adheres to the stylistic and bibliographic requirements outlined in the Submission Manual.
- If available, DOI for the references should be provided.
- Please ensure that all author names are added to the submission form as you would like for them to appear in the final publication.
- In submitting work to the JIMS, writers agree to free access and use of the material published in it with proper acknowledgement of authorship.
- After an article has been accepted it may be edited for length or to conform to house style (punctuation, end note formatting etc) and the JIMS reserves the right to make the final decisions regarding editorial changes.
- Publication of accepted case reports, literature reviews and letters in each issue will be limited and publication of these article types will occur at the Editor's discretion. If articles are unable to be published in the upcoming issue, authors can choose to have their accepted articles transferred for publication on the website, or to be considered for publication in the subsequent issue.

Article

Manuscripts containing original material are accepted for consideration if neither the article nor any part of its essential substance, tables, or figures have been submitted elsewhere before appearing in the Journal.

Review

Manuscripts of (systematic) reviews are accepted for consideration if neither the article nor any part of its essential substance, tables, or figures have been submitted elsewhere before appearing in the Journal.

Case Report

We accept papers of clinical observations, consisting of the initial presentation, medical history, physical examination, tests performed, eventual outcome and discussion on the case, backed up by scientific literature.

Letter to the Editor

Letters to the editor can be submitted regarding an article published in the The journal of Israeli Medical Student (JIMS), or regarding a (bio)medical topic that is of importance or interest to our readers. The aim of letters to the editor is to spread information or opinions about medical topics and critically assess, and thereby improve, research of your colleagues or in general. All letters will be assessed by our editorial board before publication.
