Dr. Anat Robinson was born in Tel Aviv, Israel. She is an ophthalmologist and was the head of the ophthalmic ambulatory services at Rabin Medical Center.

Dr. Robinson has enjoyed the world of photography for many years. Recently she has concentrated on artistic photography. Her photographs have been exhibited in Raanana, Israel.

Her photographs present colorful, abstract displays of nature. The combination of the colors and the geometric figures in Robinson's photographs simulate an artist's paintbrush. The shading stimulates the eye and imagination of the observer.

Robinson has taken many of her photographs while flying in a powered parachute. This unique shooting angle (from the sky) allows her to achieve an awe-inspiring perception of nature's beauty.

Robinson often travels to exotic places around the world and documents in her photographs both exceptional nature and intriguing cultures. She is a member of a forum of creative scientists in Israel who display their artistic works from time to time.

With her photographs, Robinson aims to capture the unity between the individual and the surrounding natural forces. This union creates an exponential myriad of sensory integration of sight and being and a positivity of all matter. *The Lonely Tree Facing the Dead Sea on A Grey Winter Day* shows a living tree without leaves surrounded by a cloudy grey sky, which is unusual in the Dead Sea area, but exemplifies this unification.
